

A Letter from the Elders about “Phase 2”

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Praise the Lord! Clark county is officially in phase 2 and churches are now allowed to have indoor assemblies (with less than 50 people). We are looking forward to gathering together for the encouragement and edification of the church. This biblical principle is especially important in difficult times such as these. However, we are also concerned about the physical health and safety of our members. For those who feel safe assembling together at the church building, you are welcome to attend. Here are some guidelines we would like you to follow during phase 2.

- If you do not feel safe coming to the church building, please continue to worship remotely from the comfort of your home. We will continue to broadcast our services on the internet and deliver DVDs of each service to those who don't have access to the internet. During the month of June, our live stream will be available at two different sites.

- If you have COVID-19 or any of the COVID-19 symptoms, please continue to worship remotely. If you have been in contact with anyone within the last two weeks who has COVID-19 or symptoms of COVID-19, please continue to worship remotely.
- If you come to the church building, please practice social distancing of at least 6 feet and don't shake hands. Please wash your hands regularly with soap. We will have hand sanitizer available at the front door.

- We recommend face coverings. We will have some face coverings available at the church.
- If you live at an assisted care facility, please continue to follow the guidelines of that facility. We are encouraging the elderly and those with underlying health conditions to continue to worship remotely during phase 2.
- At this time we are only offering our adult Sunday school service at 9:30 AM and our main Sunday morning worship service at 10:45. We have not yet decided when to start up our children's program or our mid-week services.

Please be patient with us. We will continue to have difficult decisions to make as we move forward through each phase of this process. We love you and we are praying for you every day. Please continue to pray for us as we need God's wisdom in these difficult times.
